Light Tackle and Fly Fishing

The local waters near and around the Cape Lookout National Seashore have become well known for light tackle and fly fishing opportunities. False Albacore, Red Drum, Speckled trout and Bluefish are all highly sought light tackle prizes. Join Captain Billy Brewer as he guides you to an enjoyable day fishing the inshore waters of North Carolina's Southern Outer Banks.

Inshore Ocean Fishing

Inshore waters can roughly be defined as those being within sight of our beaches. Popular target species for inshore fishing trips include Flounder, Spanish Mackerel, Kingfish, Speckled trout, Black sea bass, Bluefish, and False Albacore. Fishing these waters may involve trolling, bottom fishing or even drift fishing. These are great trips for the first time saltwater angler or for those with interest in specific inshore fishes.

Offshore Ocean Fishing

Offshore fishing generally takes place out of sight of the land. Targeted species include Mahi-Mahi (Dolphin), King Mackerel, Wahoo, Yellowfin Tuna, Bluefin Tuna, and various billfish such as Blue Marlin and White Marlin. When a fish is on excitement runs high for the deep sea fisherman. Heavy tackle, fighting chairs and long, hard fought battles are common. Full-day offshore trips provide a great adventure for the hard-core saltwater angler.

North Carolina Scuba Diving

North Carolina is heralded as one of North America's premier diving locations. With a large variety of shipwrecks laying off the coast, the waters laying off our coast are aptly known as "The Graveyard of the Atlantic." Live bottom areas provide other opportunities for scuba diving. Inside the barrier islands rock jetties and bridges provide even more areas for underwater exploration.

The Charter Boat Fleet

"Island Girl" Charters - Captain Tracy Campbell - A 50' Sportfisher, she carries up to six passengers. Tackle & bait are provided, and live bait fishing is available. In-shore, offshore, Gulf Stream, trolling or bottom fishing is available. Offering full day, half day and 3/4 day trips. Half day & 3/4 day - Spanish & Kings, full day - Wahoo, King Mackerel, Tuna, Sailfish, Marlin, Dolphin.

The "Sudden Impact" is a 40' Custom built Sportfisherman. The twin 350 H.P. Cat engines provide 22 knot cruise for a fast, comfortable and safe ride. Equipped with full electronics, 48 mile Furuno radar, VHF radio, Loran color fish finder, tackle supplied includes Penn International 50 to 130 W and light tackle Shimano TLD's and custom built rods. Boat has air conditioning and heat. U.S. Coast Guard licensed for up to 6 passengers. Captain Jerry Elliott provides experienced and caring service to make your trip enjoyable.

The "Freebird" is a 42 foot, fully loaded vessel featuring: Large cabin with lounge couches, large cockpit with 3 comfortable fishing chairs, all new Shimano reels on new custom rods loran and North Star position indicators, EPRIB (electronic positioning indicating radio beacon), 2 VHF Radios, the latest fish finding electronics, and new Si Tex Color Scope. She will cruise around 23 knots and carries up to six passengers. Captain Mike Freeman will show you a great time on the water.

"Jo Le" is a 55 foot vessel loaded with features like, 3 State Rooms, 2 Heads, Microwave, Ice Maker, VCR, TV, All the Comforts! Giant Bluefin Tuna(Seasonal), Marlin, Wahoo, Dolphin, and Billfish trips available using Peen International Tournamenttackle! Captain Ed Braxton has over 18 years of charter boat experience.

The "Rainbow" is a 35 foot motor vessel captained by Danny Harrison. She cruises around 19 knots providing a fast, comfortable ride. The boat specializes in bottom fishing for popular species such as grouper and sea bass using electric reels.

The "Mary Lee" is 36 feet in length and specializes in bottom fishing. With a cruising speed of 18 to 19 knots, she is captained by Larry Ingram.

The "Sea Mint", Captained by Curly Williams, is a 34 foot vessel with a cruise speed around 22 - 23 knots. The boat specializes in bottom fishing.

The "Diver Down" is a 42 foot long fully U.S. Coast Guard certified crew boat capable of carrying up to 18 divers to the various shipwrecks off Morehead City. There is a large swim platform on the stern of the boat with a large easy to get to stainless steel fins-on ladder and hand rails for easy access back onto the boat after your dives. As far as electronics goes....the Diver Down has it all: Loran, Radar, GPS, VHF, Hi-Band, EPRIB. She is fully capable handling any sudden rough ocean conditions.
